#### SAFETY RULES, INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

#### **SAFETY MUST HAVES:** 1. Supports must be used for all riders on a float/trailer with passengers.

- 2. Trailers must have two safety railings if passengers are riding on the trailer.
  - 3. Railings will be 18 and 36 inches up from the bed of the trailer.
  - 4. Floats must have fall protection harnesses or railings for any riders.
  - 5. Each Trailer/float must have a working fire extinguisher.

MANDATORY MEETING: TBD @ Desert Downs 8801 Railroad Dr, El Paso, TX 79924

<u>VEHICLES AND FLOAT MEASUREMENTS</u>: NOT to exceed 12ft from ground level, 50ft in length and 12ft in width, as route is a two-lane street with overhead traffic signals.

CAR, MOTORCYCLE, AND HORSE CLUBS: Limited to 10 per single entry and 20 per double entry, must ride in pairs.

NO VOICE-AMPLIFICATION ALLOWED: No microphones, megaphones, nor voice amplification devices of any sort.

**ENTRY FORM DEADLINE**: Must be received by Friday, April 8, 2022.

PARADE DAY (in-person): Saturday, April 16, 2022.

**REGISTRATION STARTS 8:00 am:** Entry Captain must report to Check-In Table for Placement.

Streets traffic closure at 9:15 am: Adhere to the parking attendants to drop off and/or pickup your group.

Check-In Table: On the Westside of Diana Dr. at Magoffin bus drop-off point, North of Hercules.

**<u>PARADE STAGING</u>**: Refer to the "Staging Map" once you receive your placement to see where your spot will be. **<u>PARADE START 10:00 am</u>**: The Parade Starter starts promptly at 10:00 am headed North up Diana Drive, turning right at Hondo Pass ending at the Hollings gate entrance to Nations Tobin Park see attached Parade Route map. **BREAKUP AREA**: Nations Tobin Park see attached map when you receive your placement.

**PARADE MOVEMENT:** All entrants Maintain an orderly fashion and Maintain gaps between the procession to 15 feet or less. Performances along the Parade Route are limited to <u>only</u> three stops, 30 seconds each. Do not slow the Parade's progression.

No Candy is to be thrown, as it causes a safety hazard. Passing candy to a person's hand is permitted.

**JUDGING:** Mark whether you wish to be judged for an award by checking the box on your entry form. Judges will decide based upon overall performance, uniformity, neatness of dress and originality.

Grand Marshall Award: Best display, originality, design, and presentation

<u>REMEMBER TO CHECK THE BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM IF YOU PLAN TO PERFORM FOR JUDGING.</u> All Awards and Prize Winners will be notified after the parade.

**MOUNTED GROUPS**: Unloading of horses at Diana & Riley Court Streets (EAST Side of Diana). It is important that your Captain check in at the registration table to get your placement number.

**BANDS:** assemble in Magoffin parking lot. Have your Captain check in at the registration table.

**ELECTED OFFICIALS AND CANDIDATES FOR OFFICE:** Park in the Magoffin VIP parking lot and must send their ENTRY Captain to register at the Registration Table for windshield placement form.

PARADE NUMBER PLACEMENT: Numbers received when registering, MUST BE DISPLAYED AT THE LEFT FRONT OF YOUR ENTRY SO THAT PARADE COORDINATORS CAN PROPERLY PLACE YOU AND JUDGES MAY DETERMINE ENTRIES WHICH ARE TO BE JUDGED! <u>If number is not displayed, entry is not eligible for judging.</u> ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE NOT ALLOWED BEFORE OR DURING THE PARADE. VIOLATORS WILL BE EXPELLED FROM THIS EVENT.
